



Grains - Soybean oil and palm oil prices rose to a seven month high this week. Solid demand is partly behind the increase, but world economic concerns are building, and U.S. soybean supplies are burdensome. This is likely to limit any further upside potential for the soybean oil and palm oil markets in the near term.
