

# ArrowStream

**Poultry** - For the week ending January 19<sup>th</sup>, chicken production was up 12% year-over-year, with increases noted across all classes of birds. Despite the staunch increases in output, the six-week rolling average was up only marginally. The larger broiler production was likely in advance of the hazardous winter weather, which may stall the recent price appreciation experienced for chicken over the past several weeks. Wing prices should be near a seasonal peak ahead of this weekend's Super Bowl, plus March Madness forward buying is likely culminating as well. Tenders remain the star performer of the bird, with prices up 3% year-over-year and the highest since early August.
