



**Poultry-** For the week ending June 20<sup>th</sup>, chicken slaughter faded from the week prior, and was down 4.6% from a year ago. Still, heavier bird weights salvaged some of the production declines as ready-to-cook supplies were down just 2.4% (y/y). Broiler chicks placed continue to indicate a supply recovery is forthcoming, but production may remain modestly behind a year ago. The chicken wing and breast meat complexes have found some support while the dark meat sector continues to struggle. Take note that the prospective July start to both basketball as well as baseball may underpin chicken wing prices, but COVID concerns however have left restaurant reopenings in question moving forward.
