

# Poultry

For the week ending June 17th, chicken output declined .2% from the previous week but was 2.3% larger than the same week last year. The six-week total for chicken production is trading 2.8% above 2016. However, tamer year over year gains in chicken output may be forthcoming. The May broiler type chick hatch was just 2% bigger than last year. If lethargic year over year chicken production gains continue, it could be especially supportive of chicken wing prices during the late summer and fall. Chicken producers may be attempting to expand output at greater levels longer term. The number of broiler layers as of June 1st was 2.2% more than the prior year and the largest since the spring of 2010.
