Seafood - Snow crab imports suffered during October. For the month, the U.S. imported 18.2% less snow crab than the previous year. Further, those imports remained expensive due to the relatively tight world supply. World snow crab supplies are expected to remain relatively limited through the Alaskan Bering Sea snow crab season which could underpin the markets.
