



Seafood - The salmon filet market has averaged above the prior year levels in recent months. This is despite solid U.S. imports. During November, total U.S. salmon imports were up 4.9% from 2017 while Atlantic salmon filet imports were bigger by 12.9%. Assuming strong imports continue, it could mitigate the upside price risk for salmon this spring.
