



Seafood - The Canadian snow crab fishing season is underway after delays brought on by COVID-19. As of May 29th, 33% of the Newfoundland snow crab quota had been landed. The Newfoundland quota this year is nearly 10% bigger than the prior season. World snow crab supplies are limited but slack food service demand has weighed on the markets. Snow crab price relief could occur in the coming months.
