Seafood - Lackluster food service demand continues to weigh on the seafood markets. That includes salmon with the import filet market well below the previous year. This is despite U.S. salmon imports during April falling 12.8% below 2019. Rising COVID-19 cases in several states could continue to dampen the restaurant industry recovery in the coming weeks. Thus, fairly attractive salmon prices are anticipated to persist into July.
